

Building Permit



A building permit and inspection are required for all new buildings, additions and alterations to existing buildings. A building permit is also required for outside improvements, including but not limited to inground swimming pools, hot tubs, porches, garages, decks, and fences. You may need a building permit for construction of a residential storage building based on size and location. If a permanent foundation will be placed under the storage shed a permit will be required as well as meeting standard set backs.
